Description	<p>Growth Rate: Fast</p> <p>Maintenance: Low</p> <p>Leaves: bright pink to the deepest burgundy, green and cream; 30–60 cm(12–24 in) (rarely 75 cm or 30 in) long and 5–10-centimetre (2.0–3.9 in) wide at the top of a woody stem; are spirally arranged into a fanlike shape at the stem tips; when maturing plants lose their lower leaves</p> <p>Flowers: 40–60-centimetre (16–24 in) long panicles of small scented flowers;</p> <p>Bloom Color: yellowish to red</p> <p>Bloom Time: Mid Summer</p> <p>Fruit: Round red berry about 8 mm diameter.</p> <p>Fruiting Time: Late Summer</p> <p>Trunk (bole): Shrub or small tree which can be unbranched or freely-branched</p> <p>Habitat: Often abundant in various types of forest (dry, dense, edges), on forested ridges, in thickets, and sometimes near beaches</p> <p>Habit: Evergreen Shrub</p>
